## 2019 FOOD AND DRINK CONCESSION RULES SHEET

1. Food stands will not be allowed to open until approved by Health Department
2. Any extra or excessive hookups will be an additional charge as per electric rate chart listed below. Any money due will be collected on Sunday.

110V – 20 Amp = \$6.00 per day	220V – 50 Amp = \$18.00 per day
220V – 30 Amp = \$11.00 per day	110V – 60 Amp = \$11.00 per day
110V – 30 Amp = \$7.00 per day	220V – 80 Amp = \$21.50 per day
220V – 40 Amp = \$14.00 per day	220V – 100 Amp = \$24.50 per day
110V – 40 Amp = \$8.50 per day	
3. Wastewater must have a catch pan. Pumping will be provided at vendor's expense payable to the pumping service. No waste dumping on the grounds or down drains. Violators will be subject to removal.
4. Dumpsters are provided for refuse disposal. You **MUST** crush boxes.
5. Grease disposal must be arranged for in advance through the Fair Office at a charge of \$50.00 per 55 gallon barrel. Dumping grease on grounds, in dumpsters, or down drains is strictly prohibited.
6. Menu changes must be approved by the Food Committee. All foods listed on menu must be available during the Fair.
7. Insurance must be a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 – Liability and Product Liability and returned with contract listing Kendall County Fair Association as additionally insured.
8. Security will be here 24 hours a day, but you are responsible for your own property.
9. Ice will be available on the grounds. Check with the Fair Office upon arrival for cost.
10. Concessions stands must be off grounds by 5 pm Monday unless other arrangements are made with the Fair Office. Security will only be on duty until Sunday evening at the close of the Fair.
11. No parking around food stands or gateways. Plenty of time for early morning delivery is allowed and emergency deliveries can be worked out with the cooperation of the Fair Office.
12. Hours: Food concessions will be open for service during the hours of 10am (or before) until dusk each day of the fair. On Sunday, you will be allowed to close at 6 pm – no earlier.
13. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the grounds. No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, mopeds, or motorbikes will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
