1. All classes will be judged on quality, uniformity and attractiveness.
2. Trim the top of all root vegetables down to 1/2 - 3/4 inch. Also trim the long root of root vegetables.
3. Wash all vegetables lightly. Vegetables will be exhibited on a 9" white paper plate provided by the exhibitor.
4. JR Market Basket can be the same as 4-H Market Basket.
5. All exhibits **MUST** have been grown during the current year by the exhibitor except dry grains, which can be from the previous year.
6. Do not refrigerate or freeze items prior to bringing to the fair.

Description for display:

- Must be eight (8) and not more than twelve (12) different kinds of vegetables.
- Number of vegetables used must conform to those listed in classes 9800-9823(Senior) and 10000-10023(Junior)
- Baskets will be provided. Entrants must arrange display upon arrival at fair.
- Display must be labeled with name and variety of vegetables.
- Display must be two feet square.
- Exhibit may be put in place by exhibitor prior to judging. Market Basket will also be judged on assortment and arrangement.

Don't forget that 4-H Market Baskets can be entered in Jr Open
